\*ALWAYS BE PREPARED FOR CLASS \*DO YOUR HOMEWORK OR YOU MAY GET A ZERO \*GET TO CLASS ON TIME - -SOMETIMES THAT IS HARD \*KEEP UP WITH YOUR "STUFF" - DON'T LEAVE YOUR BOOKS IN SOMEONE ELSE'S DESK \*READ YOUR STUDENT HANDBOOK AND FOLLOW THE RULES \*BE ORGANIZED - BRING PAPER, PENS, AND PENCILS TO EVERY CLASS

## TIPS FOR PARENTS

THINGS YOU CAN EXPECT:

\*MORE HOMEWORK \*MORE LONG-TERM PROJECTS \*MOVE MOVEMENT - LARGER CAMPUS - TIRED STUDENTS \*LOTS OF PHONE CALLS FROM NEW FRIENDS \*YOUR CHILD MAY START TO EXCLUDE YOU FROM THE SCHOOL EXPERIENCE

THINGS YOU CAN DO:

\*ESTABLISH A SET STUDY TIME EACH EVENING WITH NO PHONE CALLS (FOR EXAMPLE - 7:00 TO 9:00 P.M.)

\*REQUIRE AN ASSIGNMENT PAD - CHECK IT EACH EVENING LOOK OVER COMPLETED ASSIGNMENTS

\*ESTABLISH A CALENDAR FOR LONG-RANGE ASSIGNMENTS

\*LOOK FOR INTERIM REPORTS AT MIDPOINT OF EACH NINE WEEKS

\*GRADES WILL BE VERY OBJECTIVE - FIND OUT HOW YOUR STUDENTS' TEACHERS WILL ARRIVE AT GRADES

\*READ THE SCHOOL HANDBOOK - IT IS USUALLY DISTRIBUTED DURING THE FIRST WEEK OF SCHOOL
